A Turlock detective, who has been investigating ATM skimming device crimes that have been occurring around the city, saw the suspect vehicle at a bank ATM drive-thru. The detective notified patrol officers who responded to the area and stopped the vehicle. The

male driver was positively identified as a suspect, and his vehicle was searched. In the vehicle officers located multiple skimming devices, fraudulent cards used to still victim's personal information and PINs from their accounts, along with tools and electronic equipment that are used for retrieving skimming devices.
